		Frequency Adverbs		
		Topic: Frequency Adverbs (Always, Usually, Sometimes, Never, etc.)		
		Objective:		
		Identify students' prior knowledge about adverbs of frequency through oral participation and observation.		
		Activity: "How Often?" Question Game		
		Teacher Instructions:		
		Greet the class: "Good morning everyone! Today we will talk about how often you do things. Let's see what you already know!"		
		Ask the following questions one by one:		
		 "How often do you eat pizza?" "How often do you do homework?" 		





3. "How often do you play video games?"4. "How often do you brush your teeth?"	
Allow students to answer freely. Listen carefully to see:	
 If they know adverbs like always, sometimes, never, usually, etc. If they answer with other words or only in Spanish. 	
Examples of expected answers:	
 "I always do homework." "I sometimes eat pizza." "I never play video games." 	
On't correct yet, just listen and take notes.	
Closing the Sondeo:	
"Good job! Some of you already know how to use frequency adverbs. Today, we will practice more."

Frequency Adverbs – Quick	
Explanation	
We use Frequency Adverbs to say how often we do something.	





Common Adverbs:	
• Always \rightarrow 100% of the time • Usually \rightarrow 80% • Often \rightarrow 60% • Sometimes \rightarrow 50% • Rarely \rightarrow 20% • Never \rightarrow 0%	
Structure: Subject + Frequency Adverb + main verb	
Examples:	
 I always brush my teeth. She usually eats breakfast. We sometimes play soccer. They never watch TV. 	
✓ Important:	
• Frequency adverbs go before the main verb , but after the verb "to be" .	
Examples:	
 He is always happy. They are usually late.
