



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

		We use the present perfect for an action in the past with a result now:  I've lost my passport. (= I can't find my passport now)  'Where's Linda?' 'She's gone to bed.' (= she is in bed now)  We've bought a new car. (= we have a new car now)  It's Rachel's birthday tomorrow and I haven't bought her a present.  'Bob is on holiday.' 'Oh, where has he gone?'  Can I take this newspaper? Have you finished with it?  C. Finally, students will be encouraged to make affirmative, negative and yes/no questions statements with present prefect.
